The owners of one of the dive companies that I used while traveling in Tanzania has contacted the us. He loved the newsletter and the website, and added -

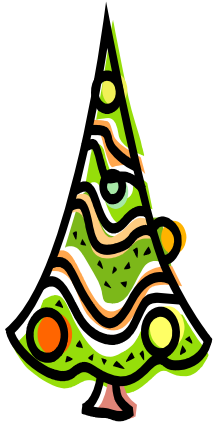
